

Borkum 2025 – Here we come!



We're heading back to Borkum for our fourth Kali training camp on the North Sea island.

A week of Armadong Kali training with Tuhon Uli Weidle on the North Sea island of Borkum: Enjoy the fresh air, stunning beach, German Wadden Sea and lots of Kali fun!

- The event is scheduled to take place from August 9th to 16th, 2025. In total, we have six days of training.
- The plan is to have six hours of supervised training a day, with plenty of time for recreation with family and friends or free practice. Young people aged 12 and over may take part in training if accompanied by a parent or guardian.

It might be that some family members or partners would like to come along to the event. They're more than welcome. During the training, they can get involved in other activities and in between training sessions there's plenty of time during the day to spend together.

Take a dip in the sea with a gentle breeze, explore the endless sand beach or enjoy a coffee in the dunes at the café called "Sturmeck". Why not enjoy an ice cream on the beach promenade in the city while you watch the seals on their sandbank or the big ships from Emden? Take the narrow stairs up the lighthouse and see how ships used to navigate without GPS.

About family rooms:

You can book family rooms if you need them. The accommodation has rooms of different sizes for this purpose. As room availability is limited, it's a good idea to book early and discuss your request with the organiser, Thomas Müller <thomasmuelleros72@googlemail.com>.

A word from the organisers:

We'd be really grateful if you could do us a favour.

Pekiti-Tirsia Osnabrück has arranged accommodation at the TUS Borkum Guest House. It's a youth hostel with multi-bed rooms. It's right behind the dunes, close to the beach.

If you could make an early booking, that would be a great help to us. As the organisers, we don't benefit financially from this. We'd also prefer not to pay extra. If you book early, you'll help us make sure the event goes ahead without taking on too much financial risk.

Booking info:

To take part in the training camp, you have to **register by email no later than 20 September 2024**. Just send your name and the names of anyone else you're booking for to [<thomasmuelleros72@googlemail.com>](mailto:thomasmuelleros72@googlemail.com).

We'll need a deposit of 170 EUR per person. I'll get back to you after you've registered with all the payment details. Just a heads-up: we need the full down payment by 24 September 2024.

Just to let you know about our cancellation policy:

As the organiser, we have to guarantee your booking at the guest house well in advance. For that reason, we have to set out some cancellation conditions:

If you cancel your booking at any point up to a week before the event, we'll charge a cancellation fee of 170 EUR. So we won't refund the deposit. If you cancel less than a week before the event or don't show up, we'll still need to charge the full amount for your booked option.

We won't charge you for accommodation / training if someone else on our waiting list takes your place at the guest house and/or training.

Here's how to get to Borkum:

You can get a ferry from Emden (Germany) or Eemshaven (Netherlands) that will take you and your car. You can leave your car at these ports for the week and take the ferries on foot. If you're coming by train, you can get off at the station right next to the ferry at both harbours (Emden Außenhafen and Eemshaven). If you're coming from Germany, it's probably best to go via Eemshaven by car or Emden by train.

Once you've arrived at Borkum Reede (harbour), you can get to the city of Borkum by train.
